## **Historical Sketch**

On November 12, 1857, Dutch army surgeon Pompe van Meerdervoort initiated medical lectures in the Dutch language to government doctor Ryojyun Matsumoto and 11 other persons. This medical school called Igaku Denshusho is the origin of today's School of Medicine as well as Nagasaki University.

A total of 979 teachers and students were victimized: 897 from Nagasaki Medical College (including Specialized School of Medicine and Specialized School of Pharmaceutics), 54 from Nagasaki Normal School, 27 from Nagasaki Higher Commercial School, and one from Nagasaki Youth Normal School.
