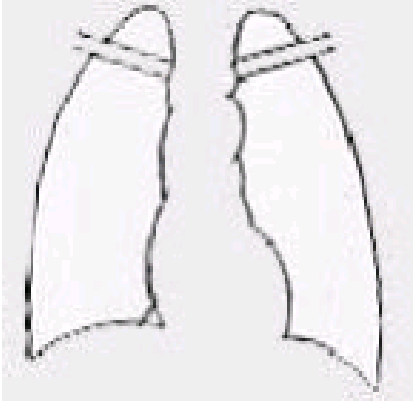

Note 1: For blood glucose testing, perform a fasting or random (casual) plasma glucose test. To the extent possible, avoid drawing blood less than 3.5 hours after the start of the most recent meal.

Note 2: "Other testing" refers to a fecal (stool) culture, which is performed in the case of food service workers employed in school or hospital cafeterias/kitchens.

Note 3: In accordance with Article 43 of the Ordinance on Industrial Safety and Health, this examination should be performed no more than 3 months prior to employment start date.

Note 4: Be sure to get a regular employee medical examination within one year of getting this pre-employment examination.
