授業のねらい/授業方法(学習指導法)/授業到達目標 <p>授業のねらい: This course is designed to improve students' proficiency in listening to and speaking English. The speaking component of the course takes students through the three primary language learning stages: rote, creative, and impromptu. The listening component trains students ears to recognize commonly heard colloquial English patterns by training their mouths to make correctly the sounds and patterns heard in everyday English conversation. Most importantly, this course will teach students how to learn English (or any other foreign language) effectively on their own. This course is about learning how to learn!</p> <p>授業方法: Students will be given a variety of activities in class (games, challenges, drills, listening activities, etc.) in each of the three stages of language acquisition. Class will be highly participatory, with ample opportunity for real practice. Outside of class, students will be asked to view a variety of A/V materials (movies, Internet, etc.), to practice their speaking every day, and to practice the study techniques they learn in class.</p> <p>授業到達目標: By the end of the term, students will be able to, among other things:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - communicate better with native speakers in colloquial English - continue their study of English effectively on their own by learning new techniques for studying and practicing a foreign language - have confidence in their ability to express themselves in English and have meaningful conversations with native English speakers.
